Refunds of \$3.50 or less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

RETURNED CHECKS , DECLINED CREDIT OR DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Deliquent Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Show Secretary will add a \$30.00 fee to the amount of the check for completing the transaction and or reprocessing the entries.

Attention Exhibitors

Exhibitor Rule Change Effective 01/01/2010. Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. For complete detail see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1.

Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008. The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events, (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). The current 50 cents recording fee will continue to be collected where applicable. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Events Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. These event services and recording fees shall be forwarded to the American Kennel Club along with all other required event results with seven (7) days of the close of the event.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS: Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the address provided. No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph, fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent entered a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete. **THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.** Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show, no refund of entry fee may be made.

No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the Show. The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class.

LOSS OR DAMAGE: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Event. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the Show.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

Veteran Class (7ys & under 10yrs)

Veteran Class (10ys & older)

The winners of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Any veterans defeated in these classes may not compete for Best of Breed, even if entered in the class. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties shows.

Best of Breed Competition

Best of Breed Competition: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed/Variety Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed/Variety Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

Grand Champion Competition

The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition:

1. Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class. There are no additional entry fees or cost to exhibitors for participation in this competition at AKC events.
2. Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed.
3. Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition (altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible).
4. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. And their winning BOB/BOV or BOS will still allow the awarding of Select Dog/Bitch to eligible dogs in the ring.

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to: 1. Best of Breed or Variety. 2. Best of Opposite Sex. 3. Select Dog. 4. Select Bitch. Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed completion and in breeds that are divided into varieties, Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Variety competition.

Award of Merit for Superior Quality: In addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, the judge may at his discretion, may recall into the ring one dog/bitch to be awarded a special trophy or rosette. This Rosette is reserved for the quality animal the Judge feels is worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed in recognition of their merit.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple dog entries)

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - Effective 01/1/2005- A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace must have at least one common owner. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only" An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class".

Sweepstakes is open to all registered dogs that are 6 months of age & under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs shown in sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to regular classes. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional class".

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

Puppy 6 mos. & under 9 mos.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all registered dogs that are 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. Entrants may or may not be finished champions. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to regular classes. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional class".

Pointer (German Wirehaired) Only

Novice Junior Class – For boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class – For boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class- For boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - For boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class – For boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class- For boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Junior Class - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: JUNIOR HANDLER MUST INCLUDE THEIR AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER ON EACH ENTRY. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, judges Education Department. 919-816-3776. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE SUBSTITUTION OF DOG: There can be an administration fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at this show.

Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The F55 competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include: AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. F55 number or F55 registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and F55 breed entries.

All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.

Ribbons for Best Four to Six Puppy in Show will be as follows:
Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show – Pink & Green

Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition will be offered in a separate ring(s) from the regular class judging in order to avoid delays in the judging of regular classes. Classes will not be divided by sex in this competition. The show results and event service fee of \$2.00 per entry must be submitted to AKC Event Operations within seven (7) days of the event (electronic results submissions are preferred). Clubs holding Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition will receive credit for completing both a Major Activity as well as an Additional Activity for judges gaining experience on their unapproved breeds by judging at the event. Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs. Male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld. Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements.

However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy classes. Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs. No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

FROM THE NORTH: Take Exit #182 to I-405 Southbound, follow it south to Exit #14-A to HWY 520 East to Redmond and follow directions below **"From I-405."**

FROM I-5 SOUTH: Take Exit #154 to I-405 Northbound, follow it north to Exit #14 to Hwy 520 East to Redmond and follow directions below **"From I-405."**

FROM I-90 East: Take Exit #10 to i-405 Northbound and follow direction below **"From I-405."**

From I-405: Take Exit #14 for Hwy 520 East to Redmond. Go east on 520 for approx. 5 Miles to the W. Lake Sammamish Parkway exit. Take the right of the 2 lanes on the exit ramp and turn right at traffic light onto W. Lake Sammamish Pkwy. Immediately move to the left turn lane and turn left at the traffic light into Marymoor Park. Follow the main road and look for Show/Parking signs.

ENTRY INTO SHOW SITE AND PARKING AREAS

No entry into show site or parking areas will be permitted until after 4:00 P.M. Thursday, August 21, 2014. Please be aware that parking or waiting for access to show venue on public streets is a violation of King County laws and violators are subject to being cited and fined.

PARKING & GROOMING SUPERVISED BY SAMMIMISH KC AND ITS DESIGNEES

All of those Specialty Clubs that have reserved space(s) in the first row only of RV parking, will be allowed to reserve the space directly in front of their parking space(s) for grooming or other usage. The width of the reserved area will not exceed the width of the parking space(s) and will only extend 10 feet directly in front of the parking space(s). Any usage of this area that exceeds 10 feet in front of the parking space(s) will block block the fire lane and will not be allowed. Fire lanes will be strictly enforced at all times by Sammamish Kennel Club.
